Anti-Ragging Committee

Anti-Ragging committee has been constituted in the college to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging including any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or writtenor by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student, or indulging in unfair means or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension.

Anti-Ragging Policy

According to the UGC Regulation on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Institutions, 2009, ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts:

- Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an
 act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any
 other student.
- Indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student.
- Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do
 and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or
 embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any
 other student.
- Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher.
- Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
- Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students.

- Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual
 assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or
 any other danger to health or person;
- Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post, public insults which would also
 include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or
 passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student.
- Any act of physical or mental abuse (including bullying and exclusion) targeted at
 another student (fresher or otherwise) on the ground of colour, race, religion, caste,
 ethnicity, gender (including transgender), sexual orientation, appearance, nationality,
 regional origins, linguistic identity, place of birth, place of residence or economic
 background.

Any student or group of students found guilty of ragging in the campus or even outside thecampus shall be liable to one or more of the following punishments:

- Debarring from appearing in any house test / University Examination
- Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges
- Withdrawing scholarships and other benefits
- Suspension from the college for a period of one month.

Objectives of Anti Ragging Committee

- To aware the students of dehumanizing effect of ragging inherent in its perversity.
- To keep a continuous watch and vigil over ragging so as to prevent its occurrence andrecurrence.
- To promptly and stringently deal with the incidents of ragging brought to our notice.
- To generate an atmosphere of discipline by sending a clear message that no act
 of ragging shall be tolerated and any act of ragging shall not go unnoticed and
 unpunished.


Action taken Report



A Lecture on the topic "Ragging: A Public Health Problem" was given by Dr. Rakesh Mahajan.


